## High level meetings (HLM)



A number of meetings, to be held around the time of the UN General Assembly (18-23 September), will be important advocacy moments. The HLM on TB is a chance for the international community to take stock of progress against their commitments to meet the target of ending the disease by 2030, made at the first HLM in 2018. And there will also be the first ever HLM on pandemic prevention, preparedness and response.
