

gifts in wills

Thank you for considering donating to Results through a gift in your will. By directing a legacy donation to Results, you'll be supporting our advocacy for years to come on a range of issues, from improving access to essential vaccines to investments in improving child and maternal health.

Leaving a gift in your will is a personal and private decision. You may find it helpful to speak to your solicitor for advice and support.

Types of legacies

There are two ways you can leave a legacy in your will. You can choose to leave a specific sum of money, this is known as a pecuniary legacy, or a percentage of your estate, this is known as a residuary legacy. You may find it helpful to discuss with your solicitor which option would be best for you.

If you have already written your will, you can have either one of these paragraphs added as a Codicil without needing to rewrite your entire will. Please contact your solicitor and ask them to insert ONE of the following paragraphs into your will:

For pecuniary legacies:

For residuary legacies:
