ADVOCACY IN ACTION

2025 was one of the toughest years for international development in decades. But it also showed why persistent, evidence-led and people-powered advocacy matters. They asked, we listened! MPs told us they need to hear from their constituents, so our volunteers ramped up their work. See their results below.

£1.25 BILLION

UK investment in Gavi, The Vaccine Alliance

Results UK worked with partners in the UK and internationally to build political support for investment that will help protect millions more children from preventable disease.

Working with civil society partners in Africa, we supported advocacy encouraging their governments to make the case directly to the UK Government – an approach the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO) later identified as particularly effective.

A new Parliament and new relationships to build

Following the 2024 General Election, Results UK set about building relationships with a new generation of parliamentarians.

By the end of 2025, we were working with:



From Supporter to Champion, these categories reflect increasing levels of engagement by parliamentarians – from showing interest in our issues, to taking action, leading advocacy and actively championing change.

Our number of active parliamentary Advocates more than doubled, from 17 to 41.

Four MPs also joined a Results UK delegation to Geneva to meet leading global health organisations and see first-hand how UK investment saves lives and strengthens health systems.
